# CAPITALIZE ON SAUDI ARABIA'S BOOMING LIGHTING SECTOR

Saudi Arabia's construction sector is in a period of unprecedented growth, fueled by over US \$1.06 trillion in projects and transformative mega-developments under Vision 2030. The Kingdom's preparations for Expo 2030 and the FIFA World Cup 2034 are further accelerating demand across all supporting industries.

For the lighting sector, this growth translates into surging demand in residential, commercial, hospitality, and public infrastructure projects. The Lighting Design & Technology Expo is strategically positioned to meet this demand, connecting global expertise with local opportunities to shape the future of Saudi Arabia's built environment.

## LIGHTING INDUSTRY OUTLOOK IN THE KINGDOM

Saudi Arabia's lighting market is projected to reach US \$2.1 billion by 2033, growing at a steady 5.05% CAGR from 2025–2033.

What's fueling market growth:

- **Massive infrastructure expansion:** Vision 2030 is fueling large-scale construction of smart cities, business zones, residential projects, and entertainment hubs – all requiring modern, energy-efficient lighting.
- **Smart & sustainable solutions:** Developers are shifting toward LED and intelligent lighting systems to meet sustainability goals and improve efficiency.
- **Tourism boom:** With 30 million international visitors in 2024, the surge in new hotels, resorts, airports, and cultural attractions is driving demand for decorative and functional lighting, with growth set to accelerate toward Expo 2030 and the World Cup 2034.
- **Urban safety & aesthetics:** Expansion of highways, transport hubs, and public areas is increasing the need for reliable street lighting and smart city illumination systems.

These trends make lighting one of the most promising sectors for international suppliers and manufacturers seeking opportunities in Saudi Arabia.

### The Red Sea Project

**Type:** Luxury eco-tourism destination

**Location:** Red Sea coast

**Estimated Value:** \$23.6 billion

**Details:** Development of over 90 pristine islands, focusing on sustainability and luxury resorts.

### Soudah Peaks

**Type:** Mountain tourism destination

**Location:** Asir Province

**Estimated Value:** \$7.7 billion

**Details:** A 627 km<sup>2</sup> development aimed at boosting tourism in the Asir region.

### Mall of Saudi

**Type:** Retail and entertainment complex

**Location:** Riyadh

**Estimated Value:** \$3.2 billion

**Details:** Features an indoor snow park, amusement park, and luxury hotels.

### Qiddiya Entertainment City

**Type:** Entertainment and sports complex

**Location:** Southwest of Riyadh

**Estimated Value:** \$36 billion

**Details:** Plans include Six Flags theme park, motorsport districts, and 12,000 residential units.

### Jeddah Economic City

**Type:** Mixed-use urban development

**Location:** Jeddah

**Estimated Value:** \$30 billion

**Details:** Home to the Jeddah Tower, the tallest building in the world upon completion.

### Diriyah Gate

**Type:** Cultural and heritage development

**Location:** Riyadh

**Estimated Value:** \$20 billion

**Details:** Restoration of the UNESCO World Heritage site to boost tourism.

### The Line (NEOM)

**Type:** Linear smart city

**Location:** Tabuk Province

**Estimated Value:** \$100–200 billion

**Details:** A 170 km mirrored city designed to house 9 million residents, featuring zero-emission transportation and vertical living spaces

### Amaala

**Type:** Luxury tourism destination

**Location:** Northwestern coast

**Estimated Value:** \$2 billion

**Details:** A luxury destination with yachting clubs, marinas, and retail outlets.

### Sindalah Island (NEOM)

**Type:** Luxury tourism island

**Location:** NEOM

**Estimated Value:** Part of NEOM's broader development

**Details:** Features a marina, golf course, and luxury boutiques, targeting high-net-worth visitors.

### New Murabba

**Type:** Mixed-use urban development

**Location:** Riyadh

**Estimated Value:** \$50 billion

**Details:** Massive new downtown development covering 19 sq km with a target completion by 2030.
